Earthquake/Emergency Preparedness Kit for ALL Students

Note: If your child is a current student and has an Emergency Kit at school, you will just need to update the perishable items.

The state of Oregon has mandated that all schools be prepared for an earthquake or other emergency. In order to comply with this mandate, we are requiring all students to have an Earthquake/Emergency Preparedness Kit. These kits are designed to bring short-term comfort for **each student** in the event of an earthquake or any other event that would cause a delay in parent pick up. All the items for the kit should be placed in a gallon “zip-lock” type bag, **clearly marked with your child’s name along with a list of emergency phone numbers including at least one out of state number, if possible.** Please have your child bring this kit to school on the first day along with their other school supplies.

Emergency kits should contain the following:

- Space Blanket (can be found in the “camping” section of many stores)
- Plastic Garbage Bag (large enough to fit your child or a rain poncho)
- Packaged Juice Drink (check expiration date)
- Small Package of Tissue
- Small Package of Towelettes or wipes
- Small Bottle of Water
- **Four nonperishable** food items: (suggestions below)
Pudding, raisins, crackers, jerky, granola bar, fruit cup, Vienna sausage, fruit snacks, applesauce
- Disposable Utensils (if needed)

** If your child has special medical needs, please provide extra prescription medication in a prescription-labeled bottle with directions that will be kept in the office for emergency use only.
