

Earthquake Preparedness Kit

The state of Oregon had mandated that all schools be prepared for an earthquake emergency. In order to comply with this mandate, we are requiring all students to have an Earthquake Preparedness Kit. These kits are designed to bring short-term comfort for each student in the event of an earthquake or any other event that would cause a delay in parent pick up. All the items for the kit should be placed in a gallon “zip-lock” type bag, **clearly marked with your child’s name along with a list of emergency phone numbers including at least one out of state number, if possible.** Please have your child bring this kit to school on the first day along with their other school supplies.

These kits should contain the following:

- 1 Space Blanket (can be purchased at any “camping” type store)
- 1 Plastic Garbage Bag (to be used as a rain poncho make sure it is large enough to fit your child)
- 1 Packaged Juice Drink (check expiration date)
- 1 Small Package of Tissue
- 1 Small Package of Towelettes
- 1 Small Bottle of Water

Disposable Utensils (as needed)

Four of the following **nonperishable** items:

- Pudding
- Raisins
- Cheese and Crackers
- Beef Jerky
- Granola Bar
- Fruit Cup
- Vienna Sausage
- Fruit Snacks (eg: Fruit Rollups)
- Applesauce

** If your child has special medical needs, please provide extra prescription medication in a prescription-labeled bottle with directions that will be kept in the office for emergency use only.
